


Behind the roman trace in Alcalá de Henares Archaeological site of Complutum

Roman city of Complutum: The set is the origin of the current Alcalá de Henares, was a Roman city built in the first century A.D., but was restored and renovated in the third century A.D. Conceived in this place for the excellent position between several channels of communication and its proximity to natural sources of resources such as Henares river or surrounding meadows.

The Roman presence in the area would cover around six centuries, from the first century B.C. until the end of the Roman Empire. According to archaeological and epigraphic evidence, the city had a great development in the Roman Empire until the fall of the Empire in the fifth century.

ITINERARY

Complutum: It consists of an archaeological site that includes the old monumental forum and you can see remains of buildings such as the monumental facade, roads and hydraulic infrastructure, Miracle Paredon (Northern Curia facade and the Basilica), the civil Basilica, the market or the hot springs.

The city, which reached an area of over 50 hectares, stood beside the road linking Emerita Augusta with Caesar Augusta, which made her one of the most important cities in the Iberian Peninsula.

Grifos House: Located in the central part of the remains, it is a building built in the middle of the first century and was in use until the fourth century, when it was destroyed by fire. It was one of the best domus of the city, with amenities such as fireplaces, storage and distribution system of water and a large porch.

Hippolytus House: It was in the old headquarters of the Complutum College Youth, all the structures documented in the building belong to the field of leisure, the room appears a large mosaic depicting a fishing scene. The work is signed by Hippolytus, a teacher from Tunisia and was made for one of the most important families in the city.
