



Cuenca: Built on the edge of rock walls in the middle of mountains, in the old town it retains a rich and well preserved architectural heritage. It extends from the top of the promontory overlooking the ruins of the Moorish castle, the ancient citadel of Kunka.

The "High city", responds to the medieval layout that characterizes the city, begins in front of the parish of Our Lady of Light, at the foot of the bridge of San Anton. Here a tour of the hills, steps and viewpoints which provide beautiful views starts.

ITINERARIO

Hanging Houses: Emblematic monument of the city, dating from the fifteenth century, wooden balconies hanging over the bed of the river Huécar, but across the river to see one of the best views. One house houses the Museum of Spanish Abstract Art, one of the best in Spain. This is of the monuments that are best seen in the distance because you realize how enduring and wonder of their viewpoints and verticality of these buildings civilians.

Cathedral: Built in the twelfth century, it represents one of the earliest examples of Gothic architecture in Spain. It is an exceptional building with elements of the transition from Romanesque to Gothic. It has a Latin cross, with three naves and transept.

Episcopal Palace: Annex to the Cathedral, it houses the Diocesan Museum, is the result of the changes and reforms that have been carried out since construction began in the XIII. Highlights the facade, renovated in the eighteenth century.

San Pablo Convent (current Parador): Construction began in 1523 as a Dominican convent, taking advantage of the rock structure of the sickle. The church, decadent and cover gothic style from baroque to rococo transition.
